The United States of America,

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, it appears from evidence on file in the General Land Office, that the Secretary of the Interior has approved the sale of land included in the allotment of Charles White Eagle; that payments under said sale have been completed and that the claimants, Lucile Cloud and N. K. Markuson, assignees of Fred E. Newgard, purchaser, are entitled to a patent in fee for said land, to wit:

The north half of the northeast quarter and the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section thirty-two and the west half of the west half of the northwest quarter of Section thirty-three in Township thirty-two north of Range fifty-five east of the Principal Meridian, Montana, containing one hundred sixty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, on file in the General Land Office:

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DOES GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said claimant and to the heirs of the said claimant the Land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said claimant and to the heirs and assigns of the said claimant forever. And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, **Franklin D. Roosevelt,**

President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
