TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:—

Know ye, That *James Cloyd of Dark County*

having deposited in the General Land-Office, a Certificate of the Register of the Land-Office
at *Cincinnati* whereby it appears that full payment has been made for
The northwest quarter of section Twenty six of Township
Eleven in range One east of the Meridian Line

of the lands directed to be sold at *Cincinnati*
by the Act of Congress, entitled "An Act providing for the sale of the lands of the United
States in the Territory north-west of the Ohio, and above the mouth of Kentucky river," and
of the Acts amendatory of the same: There is granted, by the United States, unto the
said *James Cloyd* the *Quarter* lot or
section of land above described: To have and to hold the said *Quarter*
lot or section of land, with the appurtenances, unto said *James Cloyd*
his — — — — — heirs and assigns for ever.
