To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, Winnie Cloyd of Logan County,
Oklahoma Territory

has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Kingfisher, Oklahoma Territory, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Winnie Cloyd

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands,"

and the acts supplemental thereto, for the South East quarter of Section nineteen in Township nineteen North of Range four West of Indian Meridian in Oklahoma Territory, containing one hundred and sixty acres,

according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Winnie Cloyd

Now know ye, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said Winnie Cloyd

and to her heirs, the said tract above described: To HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Winnie Cloyd
and to her heirs and assigns forever.
